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AGREED TERMS

1. Interpretation

1.1 The following definitions and rules of interpretation apply in this agreement.

1 Business Day: a day, other than a Saturday, Sunday or public holiday in Australia, when banks in Sydney are open for business.

2 Commencement Date: the date of this agreement.

- 3 Deposit:** the deposit amount set out in clause 5.3.
- 4 Equipment:** One electric bike, as more thoroughly described in Schedule 2, all substitutions, replacements or renewals of such equipment, and all related accessories, manuals and instructions provided for it.
- 5 Payment Schedule:** Schedule 1, which sets out the sums payable under this agreement.
- 6 Rental Payments:** the payments made by or on behalf of You for hire of the Equipment.
- 7 Rental Period:** the period of hire as set out in 3 (Rental Period).
- 1.2 Clause, Schedule and paragraph headings shall not affect the interpretation of this agreement.
- 1.3 A **person** includes a natural person, corporate or unincorporated body (whether or not having separate legal personality).
- 1.4 The Schedules form part of this agreement and shall have effect as if set out in full in the body of this agreement and any reference to this agreement includes the schedules.
- 1.5 A reference to a **company** shall include any company, corporation or other body corporate, wherever and however incorporated or established.
- 1.6 Unless the context otherwise requires, words in the singular shall include the plural and in the plural shall include the singular.
- 1.7 Unless the context otherwise requires, a reference to one gender shall include a reference to the other genders.
- 1.8 A reference to a statute or statutory provision is a reference to it as it is in force as at the date of this agreement.
- 1.9 A reference to a statute or statutory provision shall include all subordinate legislation made as at the date of this agreement under that statute or statutory provision.
- 1.10 A reference to **writing** or **written** includes e-mail.
- 1.11 Any obligation on a party not to do something includes an obligation not to allow that thing to be done.
- 1.12 References to clauses and Schedules are to the clauses and Schedules of this agreement and references to paragraphs are to paragraphs of the relevant Schedule.
- 1.13 Any words following the terms **including, include, in particular, for example** or any similar expression shall be construed as illustrative and shall not limit the sense of the words, description, definition, phrase or term preceding those terms.

2. Rental

- 2.1 Gospringo shall hire the Equipment to You subject to the terms and conditions of this agreement.
- 2.2 Gospringo shall not, other than in the exercise of its rights under this agreement or applicable law, interfere with Your quiet possession of the Equipment.

3. Rental Period

Subject to clause 4, the Rental Period starts on the Commencement Date and shall continue until the termination of this agreement in accordance with its terms.

4. Condition Precedent

- 4.1 This agreement will only commence when:
 - (a) You have completed the safety induction as set out in Schedule 3 to this agreement; and
 - (b) You have signed the warranty and waiver in Schedule 4 to this agreement.

5. Rental Payments and Deposit

- 5.1 You shall pay the Rental Payments to Gospringo in accordance with the Payment Schedule. The Rental Payments shall be paid in Australian Dollars (AUD) and shall be made by card payment or bank transfer.
- 5.2 All amounts due under this agreement shall be paid in full without any set-off, counterclaim, deduction or withholding (other than any deduction or withholding of tax as required by law).
- 5.3 The Deposit is a deposit against default by You of payment of any Rental Payments or any loss of or damage caused to the Equipment. You shall, on the date of this agreement, pay a deposit of \$200 to Gospringo. If You fail to make any Rental Payments in accordance with the Payment Schedule, or cause any loss or damage to the Equipment (in whole or in part), Gospringo shall be entitled to apply the Deposit against such default, loss or damage. You shall pay to Gospringo any sums deducted from the Deposit within ten (10) Business Days of a demand for the same. The Deposit (or balance thereof) shall be refundable within 10 Business Days of the end of the Rental Period.

6. Title and risk

- 6.1 The Equipment shall at all times remain the property of Gospringo, and You shall have no right, title or interest in or to the Equipment (save the right to possession and use of the Equipment subject to the terms and conditions of this agreement).

- 6.2 The risk of loss, theft, damage or destruction of the Equipment shall pass to You on the date of this agreement. The Equipment shall remain at Your sole risk during the Rental Period and any further term during which the Equipment is in Your possession, custody or control until such time as the Equipment is redelivered to Gospringo.
- 6.3 You shall give immediate written notice to Gospringo in the event of any loss, accident or damage to the Equipment arising out of or in connection with Your possession or use of the Equipment.

7. Your responsibilities

- 7.1 You shall during the term of this agreement and until you return the Equipment to Gospringo:
- (a) ensure that the Equipment is kept secure and operated safely, used only for the purposes for which it is designed, and operated in a proper manner and in accordance with any speed limits as set by the state of New South Wales;
 - (b) comply with the safety requirements as set out in Schedule 3 to this agreement;
 - (c) monitor and track Your use of the Equipment and attend at a nominated Gospringo location with the Equipment for servicing as set out in clause 8;
 - (d) make no alteration to the Equipment and not remove any existing component(s) from the Equipment;
 - (e) keep Gospringo fully informed of all material matters relating to the Equipment;
 - (f) at all times keep the Equipment in Your possession or control;
 - (g) at all times while the Equipment is not in use, lock the Equipment using the supplied U-Lock with the cable provided and in accordance with all reasonable directions of Gospringo;
 - (h) permit Gospringo or its duly authorised representative to inspect the Equipment at all reasonable times;
 - (i) not suffer or permit the Equipment to be confiscated, seized or taken out of Your possession or control under any distress, execution or other legal process, but if the Equipment is so confiscated, seized or taken, You shall notify Gospringo and You shall at your sole expense use your best endeavours to procure an immediate release of the Equipment and shall indemnify Gospringo on demand against all losses, costs, charges, damages and expenses incurred as a result of such confiscation;
 - (j) not use the Equipment for any unlawful purpose or any unauthorised use, including but not limited to any race or competition, the carriage of any passengers, the towage of another person, bike or other object, or any other

activity that may pose a threat to the safety and security of the Equipment, You or other person or property.

- (k) not permit any other person apart from You to use the Equipment;
- (l) ensure that at all times the Equipment remains identifiable as being Gospringo's property;
- (m) maintain the Equipment in the same condition as it was at the commencement of the Rental Period (with the exception of fair wear and tear); and
- (n) deliver up the Equipment at the end of the Rental Period at such address as Gospringo requires.

7.2 You acknowledge that Gospringo shall not be responsible for any loss of or damage to the Equipment arising out of or in connection with any negligence, misuse, mishandling of the Equipment or otherwise caused by You.

7.3 In addition, and notwithstanding any other term of this agreement, You are fully liable for:

- (a) any fines, tickets or penalties issued during the Rental Period;
- (b) any damage to the Equipment (including, but not limited to deliberate damage, negligent damage or accidental damage but excluding reasonable wear and tear) from the Commencement Date to the date you return the Equipment to Gospringo, up to the amounts specified in Schedule 5;
- (c) the loss or theft of the Equipment, up to the amounts specified in Schedule 5; and
- (d) all and damage to any person or the property of any person:
 - (i) which is caused or contributed to by You or any other person using the Equipment; or
 - (ii) which arises from Your use of the Equipment or any other person using the Equipment.

7.4 In the event of any damage to, loss of or theft of the Equipment or other loss or damage arising in connection with the use of the Equipment, You must:

- (a) immediately notify Gospringo and provide a detailed description of the incident (which shall include the date, time and location of the incident and how it happened, as well as the name and contact details of any other person involved);
- (b) where the Equipment is lost or stolen, promptly report the incident to the police and obtain an event number and police report. Immediately after obtaining the

event number and police report, provide the details of the same to Gospringo;
and

- (c) return all parts of the Equipment which have not been, lost, stolen or damaged to Gospringo.

8. Servicing

- 8.1 For each 1000km used on the Equipment or as when directed by Gospringo, You shall return the Equipment to a nominated Gospringo location for servicing.
- 8.2 Subject to clause 8.3, provided You comply with clause 8.1 and your obligations under this agreement, servicing will be carried out at the expense of Gospringo.
- 8.3 Should Gospringo identify any damage to the Equipment (excluding reasonable wear and tear), You shall be responsible for the cost of any such repairs in accordance with the terms of this agreement.

9. Limit of Liability

- 9.1 Notwithstanding any other provision in this agreement, Gospringo shall have no liability to you for any claim, loss, expense or damage arising under or in connection with this agreement including but not limited to liability in contract, tort (including negligence), misrepresentation, restitution or otherwise, to the fullest extent permitted by law, including, but not limited to section 64A of the Australian Consumer Law.
- 9.2 Clause 9.1 does not affect your statutory rights, including those given by the Australian Consumer Law.

10. Termination

- 10.1 Without affecting any other right or remedy available to it, Gospringo may terminate this agreement with immediate effect by giving written notice to You if:
 - (a) You fail to pay any amount due under this agreement on the due date for payment and remain in default not less than 5 days after being notified in writing to make such payment; or
 - (b) You commit a material breach of any other term of this agreement.
- 10.2 Without affecting any other right or remedy available to it, either party may terminate this agreement on giving not less than seven days written notice to the other party.

11. Consequences of termination

- 11.1 Upon termination of this agreement, however caused,

- (a) Gospringo's consent to Your possession and use of the Equipment shall terminate and You shall return the Equipment to Gospringo at a date, time and address to be advised by Gospringo; and
 - (b) without prejudice to any of Your other rights or remedies, You shall pay to Gospringo on demand all Rental Payments and other sums due but unpaid at the date of such demand.
- 11.2 Should you fail to return the Equipment in accordance with clause 11.1, you will continue to pay the Rental Payment until the date on which the Equipment is returned. In addition, a failure to return the Equipment in accordance with clause 11.1 may result in Gospringo reporting the Equipment as stolen to the police. You will also be required to compensate Gospringo for all its fees, expenses and damages arising out of Your failure to return the Equipment in accordance with this agreement.
- 11.3 Termination or expiry of this agreement shall not affect any rights, remedies, obligations or liabilities of the parties that have accrued up to the date of termination or expiry, including the right to claim damages in respect of any breach of the agreement that existed at or before the date of termination or expiry.

12. Entire agreement

- 12.1 This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes and extinguishes all previous agreements, promises, assurances, warranties, representations and understandings between them, whether written or oral, relating to its subject matter.
- 12.2 Each party acknowledges that in entering into this agreement it does not rely on, and shall have no remedies in respect of, any statement, representation, assurance or warranty (whether made innocently or negligently) that is not set out in this agreement. Each party agrees that it shall have no claim for innocent or negligent misrepresentation or negligent misstatement based on any statement in this agreement.

13. Variation

No variation of this agreement shall be effective unless it is in writing and signed by the parties (or their authorised representatives).

14. Notices

- 14.1 Any notice or other communication given to a party under or in connection with this agreement shall be in writing and shall be:
 - (a) delivered by hand or by pre-paid first-class post or other next working day delivery service to the address specified in clause 14.2; or
 - (b) sent by email to the address specified in clause 14.2.

14.3 Any notice or communication shall be deemed to have been received:

- (a) if delivered by hand, on signature of a delivery receipt;
(b) if sent by pre-paid first-class post or other next working day delivery service, at 9.00 am on the second Business Day after posting or at the time recorded by the delivery service; and
(c) if sent by email, at the time of transmission, or, if this time falls outside business hours in the place of receipt, when business hours resume. In this 14.3(c), business hours means 9.00am to 5.00pm on a Business Day.

14.4 This clause does not apply to the service of any proceedings or other documents in any legal action or, where applicable, any arbitration or other method of dispute resolution.

15. Waiver

No failure or delay by a party to exercise any right or remedy provided under this agreement or by law shall constitute a waiver of that or any other right or remedy, nor shall it prevent or restrict the further exercise of that or any other right or remedy. No single or partial exercise of such right or remedy shall prevent or restrict the further exercise of that or any other right or remedy.

16. Rights and remedies

Except as expressly provided in this agreement, the rights and remedies provided under this agreement are in addition to, and not exclusive of, any rights or remedies provided by law.

17. Severance

17.1 If any provision or part-provision of this agreement is or becomes invalid, illegal or unenforceable, it shall be deemed deleted, but that shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the rest of this agreement.

17.2 If any provision or part-provision of this agreement is deemed deleted under 17.1_the parties shall negotiate in good faith to agree a replacement provision that, to the greatest extent possible, achieves the intended commercial result of the original provision.

18. No partnership or agency

18.1 Nothing in this agreement is intended to, or shall be deemed to, establish any partnership or joint venture between any of the parties, constitute any party the agent of another party, or authorise any party to make or enter into any commitments for or on behalf of any other party.

18.2 Each party confirms it is acting on its own behalf and not for the benefit of any other person.

19. Governing law

This agreement and any dispute or claim (including non-contractual disputes or claims) arising out of or in connection with it or its subject matter or formation shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the law of New South Wales.

20. Jurisdiction

Each party irrevocably agrees that the courts of New South Wales shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim (including non-contractual disputes or claims) arising out of or in connection with this agreement or its subject matter or formation.

2. The first payment is due on the date of this agreement and is payable every week until You return the Equipment to Gospringo in accordance with clause 11.1.
3. The Rental Payment is comprised of the total sum of the following payments:

4. If You opt for Theft Coverage, Your liability for loss or theft, or damage as a result of loss or theft, shall be limited to \$300 provided that You have complied with the terms of this agreement and You are in arrears for no more than one week.
5. If You do not opt for Theft Coverage and the Equipment is lost or stolen, or damaged as a result of loss or theft, You will be liable for the full replacement value of the Equipment (up to the values set out in Schedule 5), together with any additional costs incurred by Gospringo incidental to the loss or theft of the Equipment.
6. After 40 weeks the e-bike (and all provided accessories) will have been paid off and will belong to the renter. The \$200 bond will be kept at the end.

Before each time you use the Equipment you will complete the following pre-riding safety checklist, as stated by the manufacturer of the Equipment:

Before every ride, it is important to carry out the following safety checks:



1. Brakes

- Ensure front and rear brakes work properly.
- Ensure brake shoe pads are not over worn and are correctly positioned in relation to the rims.
- Ensure brake control cables are lubricated, correctly adjusted and display no obvious wear.
- Ensure brake control levers are lubricated and tightly secured to the handlebar.



2. Wheels and Tires

- Ensure tires are inflated to within the recommended limit as displayed on the tire sidewall.
- Ensure tires have tread and have no bulges or excessive wear.
- Ensure rims run true and have no obvious wobbles or kinks.
- Ensure all wheel spokes are tight and not broken.
- Check that axle nuts are tight. If your bicycle is fitted with quick release axles, make sure locking levers are correctly tensioned and in the closed position.



3. Steering

- Ensure handlebar and stem are correctly adjusted and tightened, and allow proper steering.
- Ensure that the handlebars are set correctly in relation to the forks and the direction of travel.
- Check that the headset locking mechanism is properly adjusted and tightened.
- If the bicycle is fitted with handlebar end extensions, ensure they are properly positioned and tightened.



4. Chain

- Ensure chain is oiled, clean and runs smoothly.
- Extra care is required in wet or dusty conditions.



5. Bearings

- Ensure all bearings are lubricated, run freely and display no excess movement, grinding or rattling.
- Check headset, wheel bearings, pedal bearings and bottom bracket bearings.



6. Cranks and Pedals

- Ensure pedals are securely tightened to the cranks.
- Ensure cranks are securely tightened to the axle and are not bent.



7. Derailleurs

- Check that front and rear mechanisms are adjusted and function properly.
- Ensure shift and brake levers are attached to the handlebar, shift and brake.
- Ensure derailleurs, shift levers and shift and brake cables are properly lubricated.



8. Frame and Fork

- Check that the frame and fork are not bent or broken.
- If either are bent or broken, they should be replaced.



9. Accessories

- Ensure that all reflectors are properly fitted and not obscured.
- Ensure all other fittings on the bike are properly and securely fastened, and functioning.
- Ensure the rider is wearing a helmet.



10. Motor Drive Assembly and Throttle

- Ensure all motor drive components are correctly mounted and functioning properly.



11. Battery Pack

- Ensure the batteries are in good operation condition and kept fully charged.

PART 3

Whilst using the Equipment, you will comply with the following safety rules:

When riding obey the same road laws as all other road vehicles, including giving way to pedestrians, and stopping at red lights and stop signs.

For further information, contact the Road Traffic Authority, police department or Department of Motor Vehicles in your State.

Ride predictably and in a straight line. Never ride against traffic.

Use correct hand signals to indicate turning or stopping.

Ride defensively. To other road users, you may be hard to see.

Concentrate on the path ahead. Avoid pot holes, gravel, wet road markings, oil, curbs, speed bumps, drain grates and other obstacles.

Cross train tracks at a 90 degree angle or walk your bicycle across.

Expect the unexpected such as opening car doors or cars backing out of concealed driveways.

Be extra careful at intersections and when preparing to pass other vehicles.

Familiarize yourself with all the bicycle's features. Practice gear shifts, braking, and the use of toe clips and straps, if fitted.

If you are wearing loose pants, use leg clips or elastic bands to prevent them from being caught in the chain or gears. Wear proper riding attire and avoid wearing open toe shoes.

Don't carry packages or passengers that will interfere with your visibility or control of the bicycle. Don't use items that may restrict your hearing.

Do not lock up the brakes. When braking, always apply the rear brake first, then the front. The front brake is more powerful and if it is not correctly applied, you may lose control and fall.

Maintain a comfortable stopping distance from all other riders, vehicles and objects. Safe braking distances and forces are subject to the prevailing weather conditions.

Use designated bicycle paths if possible.

Wet Weather



IT IS RECOMMENDED TO NOT RIDE IN WET WEATHER This hybrid electric bicycle is not meant for use in the water (damp roads, puddles, rain, streams, etc.). Never immerse this product in water as the electrical system may be damaged.

- In wet weather you need to take extra care.
- Brake earlier, you will take up to 6 times longer distance to stop.
- Decrease your riding speed, avoid sudden braking and take corners with additional caution.
- Be more visible on the road.
- Wear reflective clothing and use safety lights.
- Potholes and slippery surfaces such as line markings and train tracks all become more hazardous and more difficult to see when wet.

Night Riding



IT IS RECOMMENDED TO NOT RIDE AT NIGHT

- Ensure bicycle is equipped with a full set of correctly positioned and clean reflectors.
- Refer to page 1 and 101 of this manual.
- Use a properly functioning lighting set comprising of a white front lamp and a red rear lamp.
- If using battery powered lights, make sure batteries are well charged.
- Some rear lights available have a flashing mechanism which enhances visibility.
- Wear reflective and light colored clothing.
- Ride at night only if necessary. Slow down and use familiar roads with street lighting, if possible.

Pedaling Technique

- Position the ball of your foot on the center of the pedal.
- When pedaling, ensure your knees are parallel to the bicycle frame.
- To absorb shock, keep your elbows slightly bent.

Hill Technique

- Gear down before a climb and continue gearing down as required to maintain pedaling speed.
- If you reach the lowest gear and are struggling, stand up on your pedals. You will then obtain more power from each pedal revolution.
- On the descent, use the high gears to avoid rapid pedaling.
- Do not exceed a comfortable speed; maintain control and take additional care.

Cornering Technique

Brake slightly before cornering and prepare to lean your body into the corner. Maintain the inside pedal at the 12 o'clock position and slightly point the inside knee in the direction you are turning. Keep the other leg straight, don't pedal through fast or tight corners. While going through the turn, keep your eyes parallel to the horizon and look as far ahead of you as possible.

Warranty and Waiver

7. I will not operate the Equipment in a negligent manner, or in violation of any laws;
8. I agree that Gospringo has given me instructions on how to use the Equipment;
9. I agree that Gospringo has given me safety procedures pertaining to the safe use of the Equipment;
10. I agree not to use the Equipment if it is in a condition that is deemed to be unsafe; and
11. I agree to return the Equipment to a nominated Gospringo location for repairs or an inspection if a fault is suspected.
